This 2 day workshop is suitable for those with some experience in detailed drawing and watercolour painting.












The workshops take place in the Old Workshop located on The Holt Estate in the South Downs National Park near Winchester in Hampshire, with good road links to the M3, A272 and A32.

This rural farming venue is a real treat where you feel that you are totally escaping, with stunning views across the estate parkland. The Old Workshop is fully accessible and parking is very near to the building.

You will enter the estate via the large white gates once you have seen the yellow butterfly signs. Proceed with care along the drive following the signs, past farm buildings on your right and estate cottages on your left. You will see the main house across the park to your right but carry on straight. At the division in the drive then bear right behind the yew hedge. You will see the Old Workshop on your right. Parking will be on the left.

BOOKING PROCEDURE, TERMS & CONDITIONS

Places on The Holt in-person workshops can be booked through the website using the assigned payment buttons.

You will then be re-directed to Paypal.

If you have an account with Paypal you will be asked to sign in or alternatively you can choose to pay by debit or credit card. You do not need to have an account with Paypal to do the latter.

You will receive confirmation of your booking within 48 hours, along with any specific workshop information.

In-person workshops are paid for in full upon booking.

If you need to cancel after the 6 week deadline your full payment will be retained.
